<b>Required Equipment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>2 - ALS Equipped Ambulances</li><li>1 - UTV (Primary)</li><li>1 - Stokes Basket</li><li>1 - ATV /UTV (Secondary)</li><li>2 - Trauma Kits / 2 - Airway Kits</li><li>2 - HD Power Cords, Generator &amp; Gas Can</li></ul>
<b>Ambulance SETUP</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Trailer hitches removed and stowed in side compartment.</li><li>• Unit stocked and cleaned, cot made and ready for a patient at all times.</li><li>• Inside the unit: Personal items, food, snacks removed and stowed.</li><li>• TEST: Cardiac monitor, Check Batteries - POWER ON / POWER OFF</li><li>• PC logged into Windows, Logged in to WARDS ELITE - OFFLINE - (Requires DATA)</li><li>• Trash cans emptied, open sterile water and IV fluids discarded.</li></ul>
<b>Primary UTV Setup Stokes Basket</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>1 - Stokes Basket secured in the back of the unit and locked into mount.</li><li>1 - Trauma Kit</li><li>1 - Airway Kit</li><li>3 - Splints SM/MED/LG</li><li>1 - Head Blocks</li><li>1 - KED Board</li></ul>
<b>ATV/UTV Setup</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>1 - Trauma Kit secured to the back rack. - (If UTV you may add the airway kit and splints)</li></ul>
<b>Recommended Items</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• EZ UP</li><li>• Coolers</li><li>• Winter Coats</li><li>• First Aid Case</li><li>• Bedding / Pillow</li><li>• All weather boots</li><li>• Rain Coat</li><li>• Snacks / Food / Beverages</li></ul>

<b>Coverage Area / Transports / Resources / Staging</b>	
<b>Coverage Area</b>	<p>Action Sports EMS covers the pit area and the track. (See: Ambulance Staging Map)</p> <p>Any 911 call from the pits should be directed to our service rather than Crandon via dispatch.</p> <p>All patient contacts in the contracted coverage area are the responsibility of Action Sports EMS.</p> <p>Assessment, treatment, wound care, refusals and transports are the responsibility of our service.</p>
<b>Transports &amp; Staff Resources</b>	<p>We treat all patients who request our services from within the confines of the venue.</p> <p><b><u>We transport all injured racers, staff and persons in our coverage area</u></b> to guarantee continuity of care and afford patients the professionalism people have come to expect from Action Sports EMS.</p> <p>Do not transfer care to another service unless we do not have enough resources on site.</p> <p>The highest level of care should remain on the property if their skills are not needed in the back of the unit for patient care. An ALS provider is not to drive the ambulance if doing so will leave the event at the BLS level of care. (State Operational Plan DHS 110.44) A BLS provider should be driving ALS calls.</p> <p>Other than significant trauma, airway management or CPR a two person crew is sufficient for calls not requiring pain management, ACLS or a Paramedic intercept. Lights and sirens is not advised unless loss of life or limb is imminent or an intercept has been paged, or pain the scale is above 7.</p> <p>Do not call for resources unless our resources are depleted or you need higher level of care.</p> <p>All transports should be taken to the closest facility - Rhinelander St. Mary's or Landing Zone</p>
<b>Intercept</b>	<p>If a ground transport requires a higher level of care or an intercept, use the radio to request an intercept from Aspirus MediEvac Ground located in Crandon, Oneida Med 1 or Rhinelander Fire.</p> <p>Monitor radio so you can speak with your intercepting service on their frequency.</p> <p>(See: Venue Communications)</p>
<b>Staging Units</b>	<p>An ambulance should be on each end of the grounds, usually by the start and one located by the red barn on HWY 8. <b><u>One unit must remain on the grounds with a legal crew with the UTV</u></b> and stokes basket at all times. There is no reason to move units or change staging locations when a unit leaves on a transport. The sole responsibility of the crew remaining on the property is to remain staged with the ambulance and UTV to service the race area until the other unit returns.</p>

<b>Air Landing Zone</b>	<b>Landing Zone is the Crandon Airport or High School Parking lot.</b> <b>Contact Forest County via radio and allow them to locate and request flight services.</b> <b>Utilize Crandon Fire and follow their direction and allow them to setup the landing zone.</b> <b>(SEE LANDING ZONE MAP)</b>



Do not use your cell phone GPS.

**DO NOT DRIVE ON COUNTY ROAD P**

HWY 8 WEST to HWY 17 NORTH to Shore Drive  
This is the only authorized route of travel.

# Ascension St. Mary's - Rhinelander

Turn **RIGHT** or **WEST** onto **HWY 8** from the grounds toward Rhinelander (Travel 22.1 miles to HWY 17 to stop lights. 🚦 ↻)

**TURN RIGHT** or **NORTH** - **HWY 17** Travel 1.7 Miles to **SHORE DRIVE** ↑

**TURN RIGHT** or **EAST** on **SHORE DRIVE** to Hospital. 🚦 ↻ H

Take the **SECOND LEFT** into the hospital, drive straight across inner hospital road past the landing zone to ambulance garage.

**GARAGE DOOR:** Turn mobile radio dial to "GARAGE" and key the mic for upwards of 15 seconds to open the garage door.

## Venue Communications:

### INTERNAL VENUE COMMUNICATION

This venue has their own radios with direct communication with security, police and event staff on the property.

### INTERCEPT COMMUNICATION

Call for an intercept on the Crandon repeater via Forest County. This frequency is programmed in the mobile and portable radios.

Request Aspirus MediEvac Ground located in Crandon.

Use the Crandon repeater via Forest County to communicate with them if they accept the call and are available.

Remain on the Crandon Repeater unless Forest County tells you that your intercept is coming from Oneida County.

#### **If Oneida Med 1 or Rhinelander fire has been dispatched:**

Acknowledge Forest County and let them know you will be switching to the Oneida County frequency.


Use Oneida on the radio dial to speak directly with your intercept coming from the Rhinelander area.

Head West on HWY 8 toward Rhinelander and communicate with your intercepting service via radio.

**Be sure to call the hospital with a patient report for every transport. Do not use the radio for a patient report.**
